Learning & development activities (EYFS curriculum)	Nappies, wipes & sudocrem
Play-based learning indoors & outdoors	Suncream, calpol
Daily routines (naptime, toileting, personal care)	Christmas party & concert
Use of nursery premises & learning environment	Christmas gifts home
Age-appropriate toys, furniture, and resources	Mothers' & Fathers' Day presents
Basic consumables necessary for care (e.g.Changing mats, cleaning materials)	Off site activities, walking aids (push chairs and safety wrist bands)
Support for your child's individual needs and wellbeing	Phonics sessions
